



The New Jersey School Climate Improvement (NJ SCI) Platform is a free online tool for data-guided school climate improvement that is currently used by a growing network of over 130 districts and 400 schools throughout NJ. The platform offers:

- Resources to support team development, a calendar of suggested meeting topics and agendas, and note-taking tools
- The NJ SCI Survey, a validated school climate instrument available in 33 languages for students and families, that is administered electronically to students in grades 3-12, staff, and parents/caregivers
- Interactive data reports with insights and the ability to compare perceptions within and across schools and by groups (e.g., grade, gender, race/ethnicity)
- Data analysis features for exploring school climate strengths and needs
- Tools for goal setting and the development of strategic plans including interactive graphs to monitor progress over time
